- The ecological footprint is a measure of human demand on the Earth's ecosystems
- Is a statistical index that directly relates our demand for natural resources with the Earth's ability to regenerate them

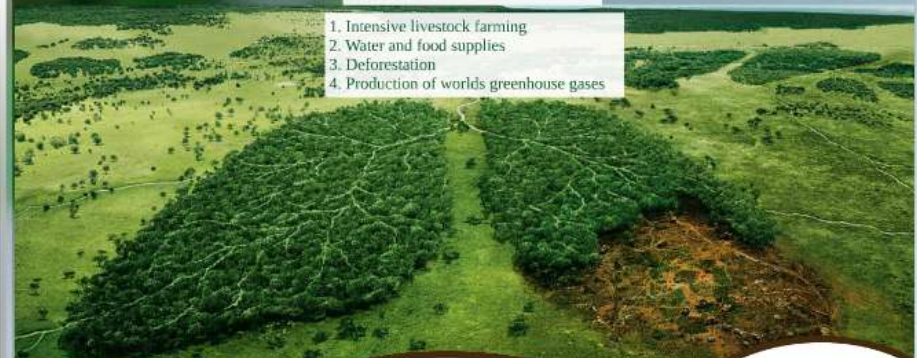

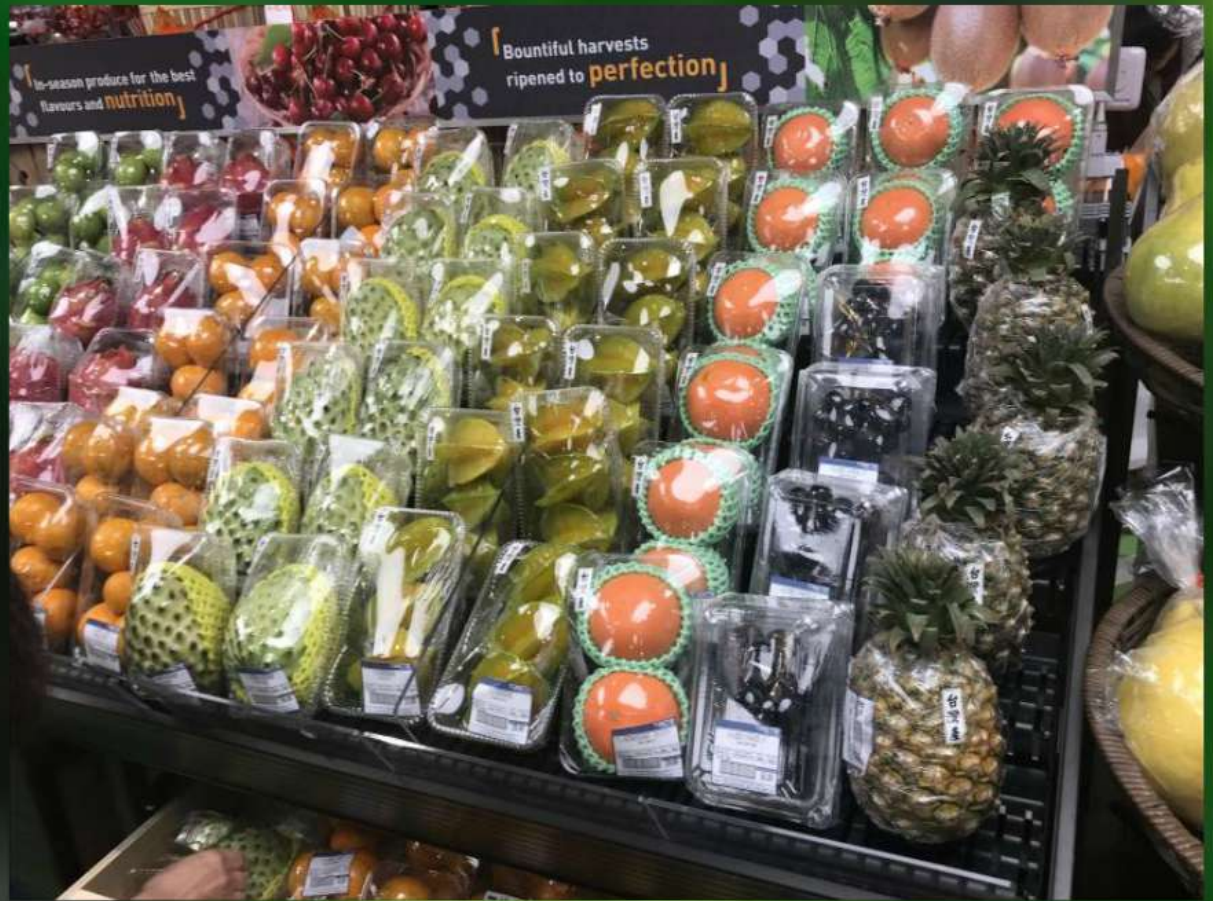

- Our carbon footprint represents the amount of greenhouse gases produced by our lifestyle choices
- The carbon Footprint is the rapidly-growing component of humanity's overall Ecological Footprint; it represents 54 % of overall Ecological Footprint

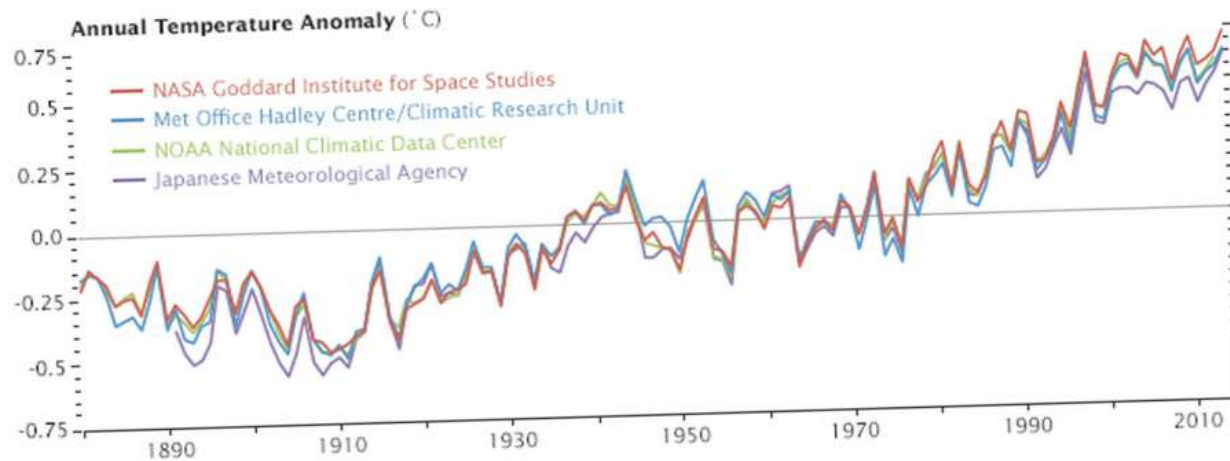

- **Global warming** refers to the long-term warming of the planet since the early 20th century, due to the increase in fossil fuel emissions

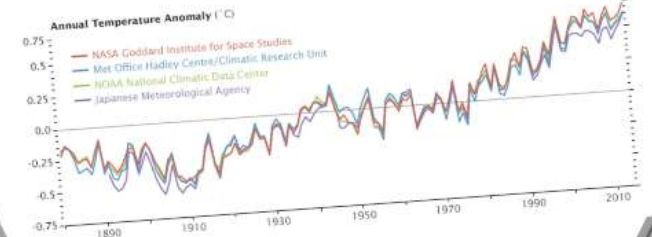
- **Climate change** refers to a broad range of global phenomena created predominantly by human activities
